Cost increase per household: \$0/yr

- Senior citizens and low income households can qualify for a property tax credit which can reduce a households property taxes.
- Millage rate estimates assume 4.5% taxable value growth in first
   5 years, followed by 3% growth each year thereafter (5 year average = 6.3%)
