

Assurances

1. The District/PSA will make their ISD/Authorizing Body approved Extended COVID-19 Learning Plan accessible through the transparency reporting link located on the District's/PSA's website no later than October 15, 2023.
2. The District/PSA will create and make available on its transparency reporting link located on the District/PSA's website, a report concerning the progress made in meeting the educational goals contained in its Extended COVID-19 Learning Plan not later than February 1, 2024, for goals it's expected would be achieved by the middle of the school year and not later than the last day of school of the 2023-2024 school year for goals the District/PSA expected would be achieved by the end of the school year.
3. Benchmark Assessments: The District/PSA will
 - o Administer NWEA/MAP growth to all students in grades 1-8 as a state-approved benchmark assessment in reading and math. LAS will use Acadience as an approved benchmark for kindergarten.
 - o Benchmark assessments will be administered during the first nine weeks of the 2023-2024 school year and again not later than the last day of the 2023-2024 school year.
4. Lowell Area Schools will provide in-person instruction for all students in grades K-12 during the 2023-2024 school year.
5. Lowell Area Schools, in consultation with the local health department, will follow all guidelines for reporting cases of Covid-19 on a weekly basis to the Kent County Health Department. LAS will follow requirements for mitigation of Covid as outlined in the Kent County Health Department "toolkit."
6. The District/PSA assures that instruction will be delivered as described in this plan and approved by the Board of Education. The description of instructional delivery in this plan matches the delivery of instruction to be delivered during the 2023-2024 school year.
7. The District/PSA will ensure that students with disabilities will be provided with equitable access to instruction and accommodation in accordance with applicable state and federal laws, rules and regulations.
